An update on Nosoon Park's fundraiser for the evangelical, gospel church in Moron, Cuba: You may recall that Nosoon has taken up the challenge of bringing their plight to our attention, with the hope that we can help them. For the last 3 weeks, Nosoon has been raising money from our congregation to assist this church in a one-time effort to help them build a second washroom in their building. The generous contributions from Calvin in the last three weeks have raised a heart-warming \$2,675.80 for this work, for which we are all grateful to our wonderful congregation and all the others who have contributed, too. We will keep the collection open until after the Sunday service on Feb. 18, for any who would still like to donate money. There will be a blue collection bucket at the back of the sanctuary where any gift for the Cuban church can be dropped (cheques can be made out to Nosoon Park). Nosoon would also like to bring to our attention that he will deliver to them any donations that we can gather of gently-used

summer clothing and/or school supplies for the people there, for which there is also great need. Please see Nosoon if you are able to help here. God bless Calvin, and its generous friends, for so heartily supporting this initiative.
