**Grocery Card Program** – Calvin Church earns 5% on the Sobeys and Zehrs grocery cards that are sold. Sobeys cards can be used at FreshCo while Zehrs cards are also good at The Superstore and No-Frills. Grocery cards are available to purchase after services.

Summer is here and, with it, the **"summer givings slump"**. While the members of Calvin are on vacation and enjoying summer activities, the life of your church goes on. But God's call on your life doesn't stop just because attendance suffers a 30% drop. We still have ministries to fund. We still have bills to pay. We still have salaries to provide. What can you do? Post-dated cheques can be left in the office. Or switch to PAR (Pre-Authorized Remittance) where money is automatically deducted from your bank account once a month. Forms are available in the Narthex or contact Margaret Woods in the office for more information.

**Canadian Foodgrains Bank** – This year is the 19<sup>th</sup> St. Andrew's (Molesworth) - Calvin (Kitchener) - Knox (Goderich) - St. Mark's (Toronto) Foodgrains Project. We will be working to raise funds for this local growing project. The Canadian Foodgrains Bank is a partnership of fifteen Canadian Christian Church Denominations and church based agencies (including Presbyterian World Service & Development) that works to end hunger in developing countries. The Bank, which is a registered charity, collects grain and cash donations to procure and supply food. It also engages in educational activities related to hunger and food security. CFB has a funding agreement with the Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA) that provides 4:1 matching grants up to a maximum of \$25 million a year. Our goal is to raise at least \$2,500.00 by September 22. Mark your regular offering envelope "Canadian Foodgrains Bank".
