**Urgent Appeal from PWS&D** - Recent extensive flooding in Malawi has led to widespread damage and destruction in southern Malawi. Dozens of people have died and hundreds have been injured. Many homes have been damaged or destroyed forcing thousands of people to be displaced. Water sources have been contaminated and water-borne diseases, as well as cholera and malaria outbreaks, are posing serious health risks. The PCC's mission staff in Malawi, the Rev. Dr. Blair and Vivian Bertrand, report that: "Close to half a million people live in compromised housing, many with contaminated water and without adequate food. The population of Malawi is incredibly young: 46% of the population is under 15, so that half a million includes about 200,000 children." Food security, nutrition, psychosocial support, water and sanitation are the priority areas of need. The PCC is accepting donations through Presbyterian World Service & Development to help our partners and victims of the flooding recover from this emergency situation.
